For those who are driving from airports or North, after going down ramp at end of Florida Turnpike extension, onto Route 1 in Florida City, proceed about ½ mile though one traffic light, and follow big green overhead hard-left-turn-sign onto Card Sound Road. If you miss this left, it adds about 45 minutes to your trip. Pay \$1 toll, go over bridge, and at dead end blinker, turn left and 1 mile to Ocean Reef Club gate. Tell Security at the gate that you are here for Bullseye Nationals Sailing Regatta and they will direct you to Baker Harbor.

When you arrive come directly to Baker Harbor to register and receive your welcome bag with directions to your rooms, dinner, and ID cards.

The weather may not be as hot as this winter's in Boston, New York and New Hampshire, but we hope it will be more predictable. It's not too late to join the racing and fun.
